- This summer your **incoming 3rd grader** has the opportunity to continue reading while earning various rewards depending on the completion of one or both sides of the bookmark.
- Bookmarks can be trimmed to look like a real bookmark. If you use the digital copy, cut and paste the 2 sides and glue the sides together to create a bookmark.
- **Silver Level:** Completion of **one** side of the bookmark, students earn an out-of-uniform pass.
- **Gold Level:** Completion of both sides of the bookmark, students will earn the above prize **And** an extra recess **with** a popsicle. (A written book talk is required on **each side** of the bookmark/2 book talks.)
- Students **must** record the **titles** on the bookmark.
- There must be a parent signature found at the bottom of the bookmark.
- **Due on the first day of school.**
